PHYSICAL & AGILITY TEST

• 1.5 mile run in 15:28 minutes, 25 sit-ups in one minute, 22 push-ups in one minute

Must be completed within 90 seconds:

- Push an occupied police car 15 feet, run 50 yards and climb either a 6-foot tall wooden or chain-link fence
- Run 50 yards and go through a 24-inch window, run 25 yards and walk a 15-foot balance beam
- Run 25 yards and drag a 165-pound mannequin 15 feet
